New COSMIC Atomic variant

- Using COSMIC desktop

composefs enabled by default

- Root partition mount now truly read only
- Important step towards better integrity guarantees
- Known issue with **systemd-remount-fs.service**
 - Unit may fail to start on your system
 - Manual workaround for now, pending automated fix
 - Root mount options are ignored in Fedora Atomic Desktops 42

Migration to a static GRUB config

- Now using a static GRUB config for all nodes
- Docs still missing on how to change some GRUB settings

Smaller changes

- Custom keyboard layout set on installation (for LUKS unlock)
 - Manual workaround for existing setups

- No longer building for PPC64LE
 - No users so we stopped the builds

What's new in Budgie Atomic?



- Plasma Discover as Software center
- GNOME Software will move your system to Fedora
 Silverblue
- Use the command line to rebase from Fedora 41 to 42

Unofficial Bootable Container images

- Close to being able to provide official container images
 <u>https://gitlab.com/fedora/ostree/sig/-/issues/2</u>
- In the meantime, **unofficial images** are on Quay.io:
 - <u>https://quay.io/organization/fedora-ostree-desktops</u>

- Now **signed** with cosign
- Available for **aarch64**

Unofficial, experimental Fedora Asahi Remix Atomic Desktops

- github.com/fedora-asahi-remix-atomic-desktops/images
- Installation path still experimental
- Help needed to make it more usable
- Does not support x86 emulation yet



- They moved to Fedora 41 and 42 on release day
- Look for announcements on their Discourse forum
